- TASK: Create 3-4 interesting questions for your group’s discussion.
- Suggestions:
 - Why do you think... ? (be specific)
 - What do you learn about... ? (be specific)
 - How has (character) developed/changed?
 - Did anything in this section of the book confuse you? surprise you? enrage you? etc.
 - What is a dominant theme in this section?
